

**FALL CREEK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

Parents are responsible for the safety and conduct of their children.

1. **Pool tags are required for entry into the facility.**
2. **All members and guests must register with the lifeguard upon entering the pool facility.**
3. **Appropriate swimwear must be worn in the pool. No cut-off jeans or pants, no denim, or other shorts. Male swimsuits are to cover undergarments in their entirety. Shirts may be worn in the pool provided that a swimsuit is worn under the shirt. Shirts must be made of a light color free from heavy dyes that may run when exposed to pool water.**
4. **A member must accompany guests at all times while in the pool area and will be held responsible for the actions of their guests. All members and their guests are required to abide by all guest policies. Residents are allowed up to 15 guests and gatherings are limited to 20 people total (including household members and guests). Gatherings of more than 20 people (including residents) is considered a party.**
5. **All pool parties must be registered with the pool management company 1 week prior to the event. Parties will be limited to non-peak hours (10am – 12pm and/or 6pm – 8pm). There is a limit of two parties at one time. Pool parties exceeding 40 people must rent out the pool area during off hours (8:00-10:00PM) and pay all applicable fees as set by the pool management company. All parties must end by 10:00PM. Pool Party fees are as follows:**
 - **Parties up to 40 people – a fee of \$17.50 per hour for 20 people and \$35.00 per hour for 40 people, plus an administrative fee of \$25.00 is required. The hourly fees cover the hiring of additional lifeguards.**
 - **Parties over 40 people (after hours) – a fee of \$100 per hour for up to 100 people, plus a \$25.00 administrative fee is required. This fee covers the minimum requirement of five lifeguards that are needed to safely oversee all swimmers. Any party exceeding 100 people will be assessed a fee of \$20.00 per hour for 101-120 guests, \$40 for 121-140 guests etc., again to cover the cost of additional lifeguards.**
6. **Swimming is allowed only when a lifeguard is on duty.**
7. **No food or beverages allowed in the pool.**
8. **No glass containers in the pool area.**
9. **Alcohol and other drugs are prohibited. Smoking is prohibited in the pool area.**
10. **Children age twelve (12) and under must be accompanied at all times by a parent or guardian over the age of eighteen (18).**
11. **Diaper changing permitted in restrooms only. Swim Diapers only permitted in pool. Appropriate attire is required for infants to permit entry into pool.**
12. **No pets permitted in pool area.**
13. **There will be a 10-minute safety break every hour. All swimmers under the age of 18 will be asked to exit the pool during this time.**
14. **No running, horseplay, foul language or loud and unruly conduct will not be tolerated.**

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15. **Persons with open wounds will not be allowed in the pool.**
16. **Two (2) lanes may be restricted for lap swim only.**
17. **Lifeguards have ultimate authority at all times. For the safety and enjoyment of all, the lifeguards have full authority to ask disruptive or unruly guests to leave the facility.**
18. **Management will not be held responsible for loss or damage of any personal property of any kind.**
19. **The pool may be closed or its use limited at any time because of weather, operational difficulties, and at the discretion of the manager. In case of lightning or thunder, Red Cross current standards will be used.**

This facility is intended for the exclusive use of the Members and guests of Fall Creek Homeowners Association, Inc. (the "Association") subject to the rules and regulations established by the Association.

PERSONS NOT FOLLOWING RULES ARE SUBJECT TO SUSPENSION OF PRIVILEGES.

Fall Creek Slide Rules

1. All riders must be at least 48" tall to ride the water slides. The only exceptions are:
 - A) Children 36-48 inches tall wearing a USCG (United States Coast Guard) approved life jacket
 - B) Children 42-48 inches tall that have passed a swimming test, administered by GHPM lifeguards. Children of residents or their guests without life jackets may not use the slide until a GHPM lifeguard has confirmed and documented that they are able to swim to required standards. Swim tests will be administered based on lifeguard availability and can be delayed during periods of heavy pool usage or staff shortages.
2. Wait for lifeguard's starting instructions before riding.
3. Enter, ride, and exit slide feet-first in a sitting position or on your back.
4. Only one person is allowed on the slide at a time. Parents may not ride with a lap child. No doubles, trains, or chains.
5. Keep arms and feet inside flume at all times.
6. Swimwear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets or metal ornamentation are not permitted.
7. Do not run, dive, stand, kneel, rotate or stop in the slide.
8. No horseplay on stairs or slide platform. This may result in a loss of sliding privileges.
9. No more than 4 people on slide platform and stairs at a time.
10. Eyeglasses must be securely affixed to riders with head straps.
11. No tubes, mats, or other flotation devices other than USCG approved flotation devices are permitted in flume.
12. Parents may not wait for child directly in front of the slide. Parents can be next to wall away from the slide exit into the splash pool area, but not the wall between the two slides.
13. Exit splashdown pool area immediately.

WARNING

Pregnant women and riders with a heart or back condition should not use this ride.

WARNING

Failure to follow slide rules can result in serious injury or death to yourself and others, such action may also result in the loss of your privileges to use slide.

FALL CREEK AQUATIC CENTER POOL ENTRANCE POLICY AND PROCEDURES

RESIDENTS WITH A POOL TAG

- (1) Residents and guests will be permitted access to the Fall Creek Aquatic Center.

RESIDENTS WITHOUT A POOL TAG

- (1) Residents will be allowed access to the Fall Creek Aquatic Center if he or she can present proof of residence with Fall Creek (e.g., Texas Driver's License or piece of mail such as a utility bill).
- (2) Residents without a pool tag will sign the daily log at the lifeguard desk and will be assessed with a "NO POOL TAG" designation.
- (2) Residents will be provided with a pool tag request form to be completed and sent to Fall Creek Homeowners Association, Inc., c/o Planned Community Management, Inc., P. O. Box 219223, Houston, Texas 77218.

RESIDENT WITH A POOL TAG THAT DOES NOT WORK

- (1) Residents will be allowed access to the Fall Creek Aquatic Center if he or she can present proof of residence within Fall Creek (e.g., Texas Driver's License or piece of mail such as a utility bill).
- (2) Residents with a unworkable pool tag will sign the daily log at the lifeguard desk and will be assessed with a "NO POOL TAG" designation.
- (3) Residents will be instructed to contact Fall Creek Homeowners Association, Inc. at (281) 870-585 to obtain a workable pool tag.

RESIDENTS WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED ACCESS TO THE FALL CREEK AQUATIC CENTER FOR FOURTEEN (14) DAYS FROM THE DATE OF THE RESIDENT'S ORIGINAL "NO POOL TAG" DESIGNATION.

Refusal to show pool tag, evidence of residency, or sign the daily log will result in denial of entry into the Fall Creek Aquatic Center. Refusal to agree to denial of entry will result in a call to the Harris County Sherriff's Police Department.
